

Nanny Referral Service Fees

All fees for nanny referral services provided by the Agency are as follows:

- For one child (less than 20 hours per week): The rate starts at \$23 per hour. For each additional child, the rate increases by \$1 per hour.
- For one child (more than 20 hours per week): The rate starts at \$22 per hour. For each additional child, there is a \$1 increase per hour.
- Group or Church Events: The rate is **\$24 per hour**.
- Children with Special Needs: The rate is **\$25 per hour**.
- Travel Fee: A \$2.50 per mile charge applies if the family requests travel during the shift. For trips over 20 miles and up to 40 miles, a flat \$80 per trip fee applies.
- Overnight Fee: The fee for overnight shifts (8:00 pm to 6:00 am) is \$165 per night.
- Short-Notice Service Fee: A \$25 per hour fee applies for a short-notice request for one child. For each additional child, the fee increases by \$1 per hour.

*Note: One-time shift requests must be paid to the agency before the shift starts!

• Minimum Shift Duration:

We require a minimum shift duration of **four hours**.

- Holidays : The agency follows the official holidays and applies the following rates:
- 1. New Year's Eve (December 31-January 1st) Rate: 2x regular rate.
- 2. Labor Day (First Monday in September) Rate: 1.5x regular rate.
- 3. Independence Day (July 4) Rate: 1.5x regular rate.
- 4. Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November) Rate: 2x regular rate.
- 5. Christmas Day (December 25) Rate: 2x regular rate.
- 6. Memorial Day (Last Monday in May) Rate: 1.5x regular rate.
- 7. Martin Luther King Jr. Day (Third Monday in January) Rate: 1.5x regular rate.
- 8. Veterans Day (November 11) Rate: 1.5x regular rate.
- 9. Easter Sunday (Date varies) Rate: 2x regular rate.
- 10. Good Friday (Date varies) Rate: 1.5x regular rate.

Payment and Cancellation Policy

• Direct Payments to Caregivers:

Any payments made directly to the caregiver are considered tips. The Agency will still charge the hourly rate and is due for payment.

• Cancellations:

The entire shift will be charged if the family cancels without at least **24 hours' notice** or returns home one hour or less earlier than scheduled.

• Example 1:

If a shift is scheduled from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and the family cancels at 7:00 a.m., the entire shift will still be charged because the cancellation was made with less than 24 hours' notice.

• Example 2:

If a shift is scheduled from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and the parent comes home at 2:00 p.m., the shift is paid until 2:00 p.m. However, if the parent returns at 4:00 p.m., the shift will be paid until 5:00 p.m. (the scheduled end time).

• Cancellation Exception:

If the cancellation is due to a **health issue** of a family member or child, the cancellation policy may be waived.

• Private Arrangements with Nannies:

Any private arrangements made directly with a nanny without the Agency's consent are prohibited and subject to a **\$1,500 charge**.
